


## **Benjamins Mill Wind Project**

Natural Forces is proposing to develop a wind energy project near Windsor, Nova Scotia. As of August 17<sup>th</sup>, the Benjamins Mill Wind Project was selected through the Rate Base Procurement Program and was awarded a contract to develop and build the first phase of the project!


Phase one of the Benjamins Mill Wind Project will consist of 8 turbines, producing approximately 34 MW of installed capacity.

Based on current timelines, it is anticipated that development of the project will continue until late winter 2023. Construction of the project is expected to start later in 2023.


### **About the Project**

The proposed Benjamins Mill Wind Project is being developed by a partnership formed between Natural Forces and Wskijnu'k Mtmo'taqnuow Agency Limited (the Agency). The Project is located in West Hants Regional Municipality in Hants County, about 3.6 km north of the Falls Lake communities and 13km southwest of Windsor. The Project will be built in several phases. In total, the Project will have an approximate capacity of up to 150 MW, representing up to 28 turbines.

The Project's phase 1 was successful in receiving a power purchase contract as part of the Nova Scotia Rate Base Procurement Program, allowing phase 1 to be built.
